DRUGS & ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES AT OUR EVENTS

The dealing in or use of illegal drugs is not condoned by the Brighton & Hove LGBT Community Safety Forum (LGBT CSF). Drug enforcement laws are as applicable with us as any other event.

Police officers often attend our events and will deal with drug offences in accordance with national guidelines. If you deal in drugs, it is likely that you will be arrested. Neither anti-social nor illegal behaviour will be tolerated and participants will leave themselves liable for eviction from the event.

If you attend one of our events or an event we are delivering a service to and bring drugs with you, you risk having them confiscated and being evicted from the event.

if you buy them on site, you risk getting ripped off; whether with fake substances or short deals, and with pills, powders and liquids there is a risk that what you buy could be harmful and even life threatening.

Experimenting with drugs can lead to adverse reactions. The crowds and the size of many events can be startling and disorientating. If you do take drugs and you become ill, depressed or frightened please ask a steward or volunteer for support and advice.
